**RESOLUTION**:- Government is pleased to direct that for Rule – 3 of the Rules for the competitive examination for recruitment to the Maharashtra Service of Engineers, Class- I and Class- II printed as Annexure I to Government Resolution, Public Works Department, No. GAB–1059–E (I), dated the 29<sup>th</sup> April 1960, the following rule should be substituted-

"Candidates will be required to submit application in such form as the Commission may prescribed and to pay a fee of Rs. 47.50 (Rs. 17.50 in the case of candidates belonging to the Backward Classes) in such manner as the commission may direct. Once an application has been considered by the Commission and the decision communicated to the candidates, ordinarily no claims from the candidates for a refund of the fee paid by him to the Commission will be entertained nor can this fee be held in reserve for any other examination or selection; if however a candidate is not admitted to the examination by the commission, a refund of Rs. 45/- (Rs. 15/- in the case of candidates belonging to the Backward Classes) will be made to him."
