RESOLUTION:- Government is pleased to direct that the following should be added at the end of Rule 2 in the recruitment Rules for Bombay Service of Engineers (I) and (II), now called Maharashtra Service of Engineers (I) and (II) printed as accompaniment to Government Resolution, Public Works Department No. GAB. 1059 – E (I), dated 29th April 1960:-

Any person appointed to the post of Assistant Engineer Class (I) or Assistant Engineer Class (II) or Deputy Engineer in the Maharashtra Service of Engineers (I) or (II) on or after the 1st November 1965 shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service or post connected with the Defence of India, any where in India or abroad, for a period of less than four years including the period spent in training, if any, on such conditions as are determined by the Government of India.

Provided that such person –

- (a) Shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment.
- (b) Shall not ordinarily be required to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of forty years.
