## GOVERNMENT OF MAHARASHTRA Irrigation Department Resolution No. GAB 1075 (117) – E (2) Mantralaya, Bombay 32 Dated the 6<sup>th</sup> June, 1978

**READ :** Government Resolution Irrigation and Power Department No. GAB-1070-E-(1), dated the 19<sup>th</sup> December, 1970.

**RESOLUTION :** Rule 14 (a) of the Rules and Procedure regarding appointment to the Maharashtra Service of Engineers Class I and Class II issued under Government Resolution, Irrigation and Power Department No. GAB 1070 - E(1), dated the 19.12.1970, provides for member of District Technical Service Class III (Engineering) under the Zilla Parishads to be eligible for appointment by selection to the Cadre of officiating Sub-Divisional Engineers and Sub-Divisional Officers, as the case may be, provided their appointments are restricted to 9 temporary posts of Sub-Divisional Engineers and 9 temporary post of Sub-Divisional Officers under the Irrigation Department and 35 temporary posts of Sub-Divisional Engineers and 34 temporary posts of Sub Divisional Officers, under the Building and communications Department, now known as Public Works and Housing Department, which are required to be reserved for them, in theses cadres. Rule 14(b) ibid. provides for review, of the number of posts reserved for promotion of members of District Technical Service Class III (Engineering) under the Zilla Parishads to Class II posts in the State Sector. The question of taking such a review had been under consideration of Government for some time past. Government is now pleased to direct that the number of posts of Sub-Divisional Engineers and Sub-Divisional Officers under the Irrigation Department and the Public Works and Housing Department for promotion of members of the District Technical Service Class III (Engineering) under the Zilla Parishads should be increased as indicated below, until further orders. :-
