The various elements that would be covered include Scope, Schedule, Cost, Human Resources, Stakeholders, Communication, Risk and Procurement. Code of ethics and Professional responsibilities for the Project Management Professionals will be another element.

- Understand specialized techniques like Critical path scheduling, critical chain scheduling, earned value analysis etc
- Modelling of the project plan using a computerized scheduling tool (Microsoft Projects 2013)
